The 122,224 dividend equivalent rights being reported reflect 22,495 dividend equivalent rights at \$36.20 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 07/06/11; 34,129 dividend equivalent rights at \$23.86 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 10/05/11; 30,590 dividend equivalent rights at \$26.62 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 01/04/12; and 35,009 dividend equivalent rights at \$23.26 per RSU credited to the Reporting Person's account on 04/04/12.
