This prospectus supplement supplements information contained in the prospectus dated November 3, 2006, included within the registration statement filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on November 3, 2006, as supplemented by Prospectus Supplement No. 1 dated November 22, 2006, Prospectus Supplement No. 2 dated December 11, 2006, Prospectus Supplement No. 3 dated December 22, 2006, Prospectus Supplement No. 4 dated January 16, 2007, Prospectus Supplement No. 5 dated February 2, 2007, Prospectus Supplement No. 6 dated March 26, 2007, and Prospectus Supplement No. 7 dated April 11, 2007, which we collectively refer to as the prospectus, covering resales by selling securityholders of our 3.70% Convertible Senior Notes due 2026 and shares of our common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes.

This prospectus supplement should be read in conjunction with, and may not be delivered or utilized without, the prospectus. This prospectus supplement is qualified by reference to the prospectus, except to the extent that the information in this prospectus supplement supersedes the information contained in the prospectus. The terms of the notes and the common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes are set forth in the prospectus.

Investing in the notes and the common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes involves risks. See Risk Factors beginning on page 6 of the prospectus, as well as the risk factors relating to our business that are incorporated by reference in the prospectus from our Annual Report on Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2006.

Neither the Securities and Exchange Commission nor any state securities commission has approved or disapproved of these securities or determined if this prospectus supplement or the prospectus is truthful or complete. Any representation to the contrary is a criminal offense.

SELLING SECURITYHOLDERS

The selling securityholders set forth below, including their transferees, pledgees or donees or their successors, may from time to time offer and sell the notes and the common stock into which the notes are convertible in certain circumstances, pursuant to this prospectus supplement and the prospectus. Based upon information provided by the selling securityholders, none of the selling securityholders set forth below has had a position, office or any other material relationship with us, or any of our predecessors or affiliates, within the past three years.

The information in the table below should be considered in addition to the information appearing in the prospectus under the heading *Selling Securityholders* and is based on information provided to us by the selling securityholders as of May 8, 2007. The number of shares of common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes shown in the table below represents the maximum number of shares of common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes assuming conversion of the full amount of notes held by each holder at the initial conversion rate of 30.5506 shares of our common stock per \$1,000 principal amounts of the notes. This conversion rate is subject to adjustments in certain circumstances. Because the selling securityholders may offer all or some portion of the notes or shares of our common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes, we have assumed for purposes of the table below that the named selling securityholders will sell all of the notes or convert all of the notes and sell all of the shares of our common stock issuable upon conversion of the notes offered pursuant to this prospectus supplement and the prospectus. In addition, the selling securityholders identified below may have sold, transferred or otherwise disposed of all or a portion of their notes since the date on which they provided the information regarding their notes in transactions exempt from the registration requirements of the Securities Act. Information about the selling securityholders may change over time. Any changed information given to us by the selling securityholders will be set forth in prospectus supplements if and when necessary or, if appropriate, a post-effective amendment to the registration statement of which the prospectus is a part. Because the selling securityholders may offer all or some portion of their notes or the underlying shares of our common stock from time to time, we cannot estimate the amount of notes or underlying shares of our common stock that will be held by the selling securityholders upon the termination of any particular offering.

To our knowledge, except as described below, the selling securityholders have sole voting and investment power with respect to all of the securities shown as beneficially owned by them.
