- (1) These shares were acquired during 2009 pursuant to a dividend reimbursement plan which provides for a broad-based participation, does not discriminate in favor of employees of Overseas Shipholding Group, Inc. and operates on substantially the same terms for plan participants.
- (2) In accordance with the terms of the Overseas Shipholding Group, Inc. 2004 Stock Incentive Plan, as amended, these 1,131 shares of common stock were surrendered to Overseas Shipholding Group, Inc. upon the January 11, 2010 vesting of 2,736 shares (the "Vested Shares") of the reporting person's restricted stock in payment of the reporting person's tax withholding liability incurred as a result of the vesting of the Vested Shares.
