On 06/03/2011, Reporting Person was awarded a number of performance-based restricted stock units (RSUs), within a preset range, with (1) the actual number contingent upon the achievement of certain performance criterion. If certain performance criterion is achieved, fifty percent (50%) of the grant vests on the third and fourth anniversaries of the date of grant, subject to applicable taxes upon delivery.
