TELMEX PROPOSES TO INCREASE FUNDS FOR SHARE REPURCHASE

Mexico City, November 10, 2004. Telefonos de Mexico, S.A. de C.V. (TELMEX) (BMV: TELMEX L; NYSE: TMX; NASDAQ: TFOY; LATIBEX: XTMXL) announced today that its Board of Directors, at a meeting held on November 10, 2004, authorized to submit a proposal to the Ordinary Shareholders Meeting to increase 8 billion Mexican pesos the funds to purchase its own shares. The Ordinary Shareholders Meeting will be held on November 30, 2004.
