PART III - NARRATIVE

The Registrant is unable to file its Quarterly Report on Form 10-QSB for the quarter ended March 31, 2002 because the Registrant is experiencing delays in the collection and compilation of certain financial information required to be included in the Form 10-QSB. The Form 10-QSB will be filed as soon as reasonably practicable and in no event later than the fifth calendar day following the prescribed due date.

PART IV - OTHER INFORMATION

In February 2002, the Registrant completed the acquisition of Cypress Communications, Inc. through a tender offer and short form merger. The transaction will be accounted for by the purchase method of accounting. During the upcoming year, Cypress Communications will be considered the predecessor, and therefore, future reporting will include prior year financial statements for Cypress as well as US RealTel.

In March 2002, the Registrant decided to discontinue its Telecom Rights

operations in Latin America. For the year ended December 31, 2001, approximately 90% of the Registrant's revenues were from its Latin American operations.
